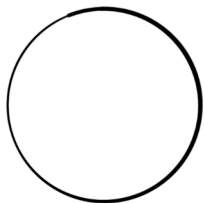


9. What would you have in your own museum? Fill, cut out and stick these frames at home to make one.

2. Welcome, have an imaginary cup of tea!

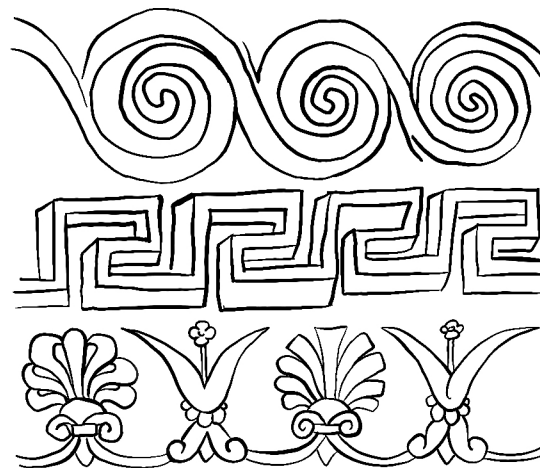


3. Can you find Fanny the family dog?

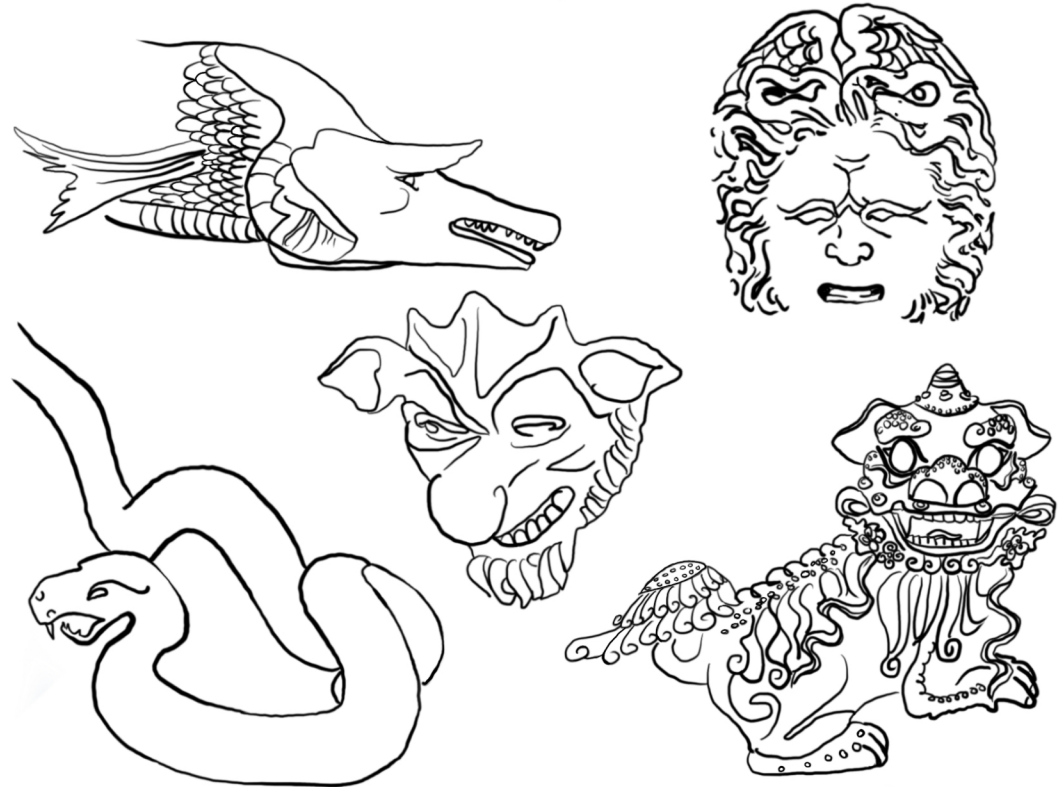
