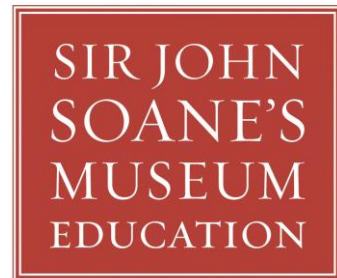


WELCOME TO SIR JOHN SOANE'S MUSEUM

Wife: Eliza

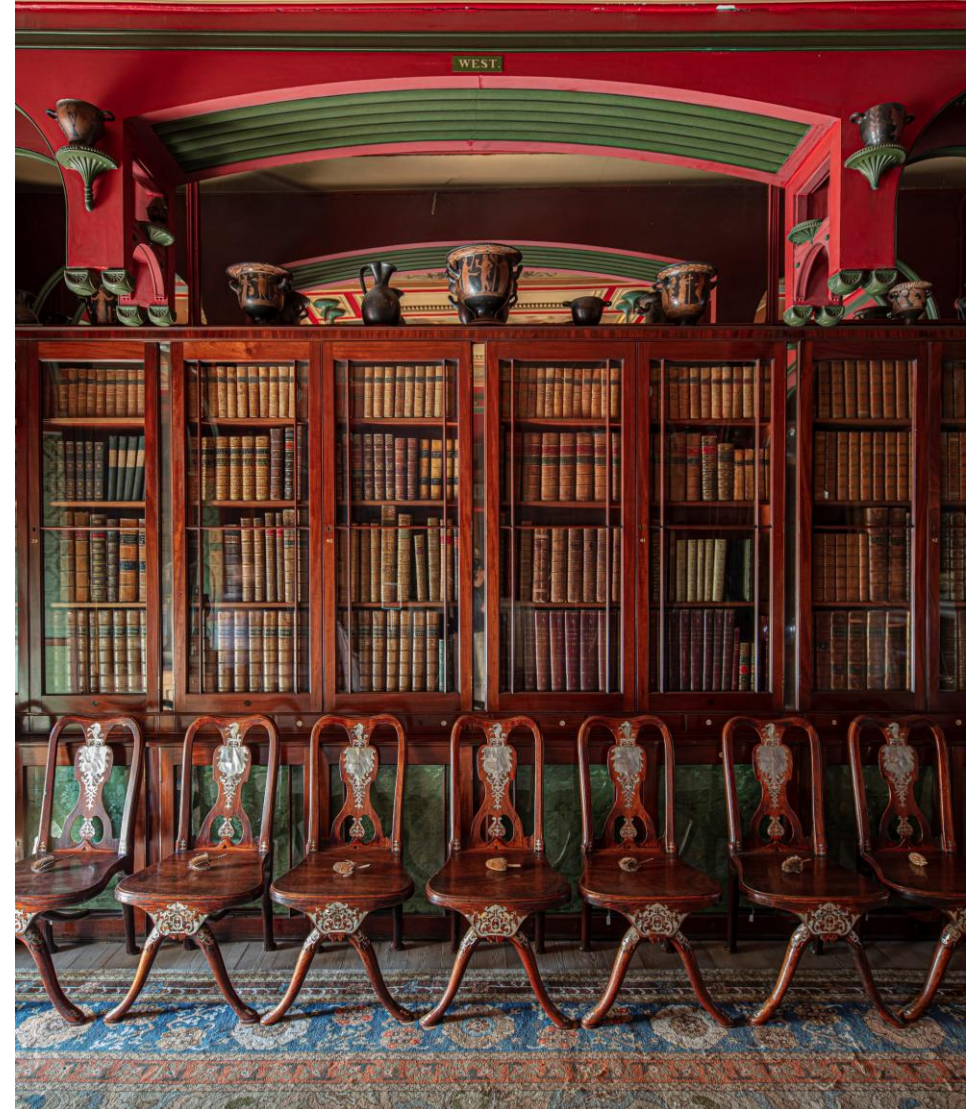


Sons: George and John Jr

The Museum has many objects.



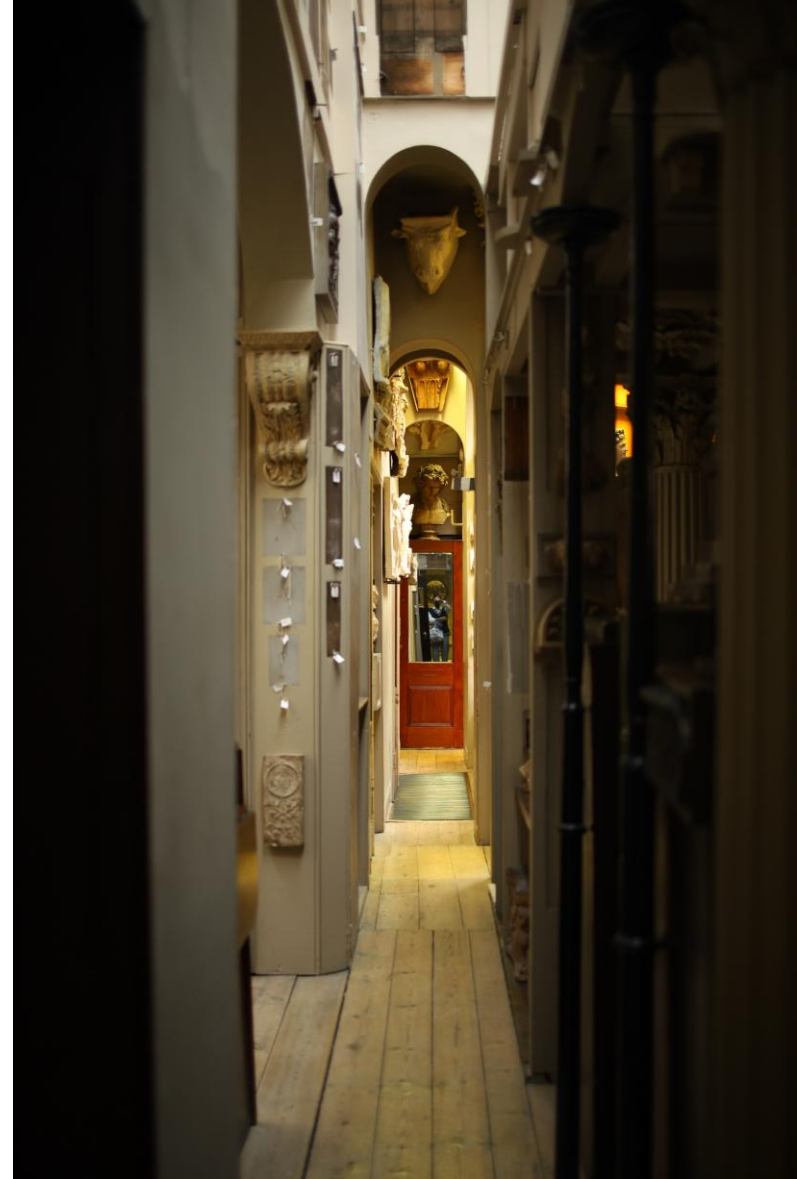
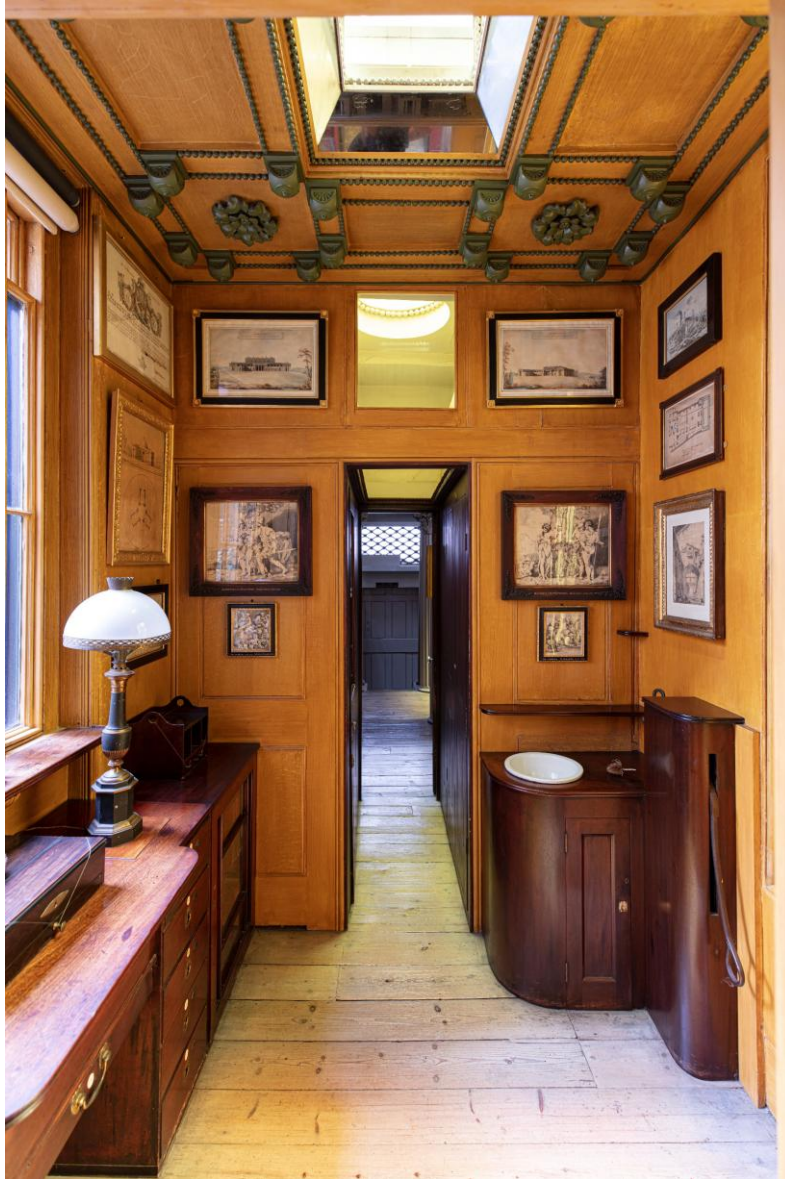
The Museum has lots of chairs and furniture but you cannot sit on them.

This is the Library Dining Room.



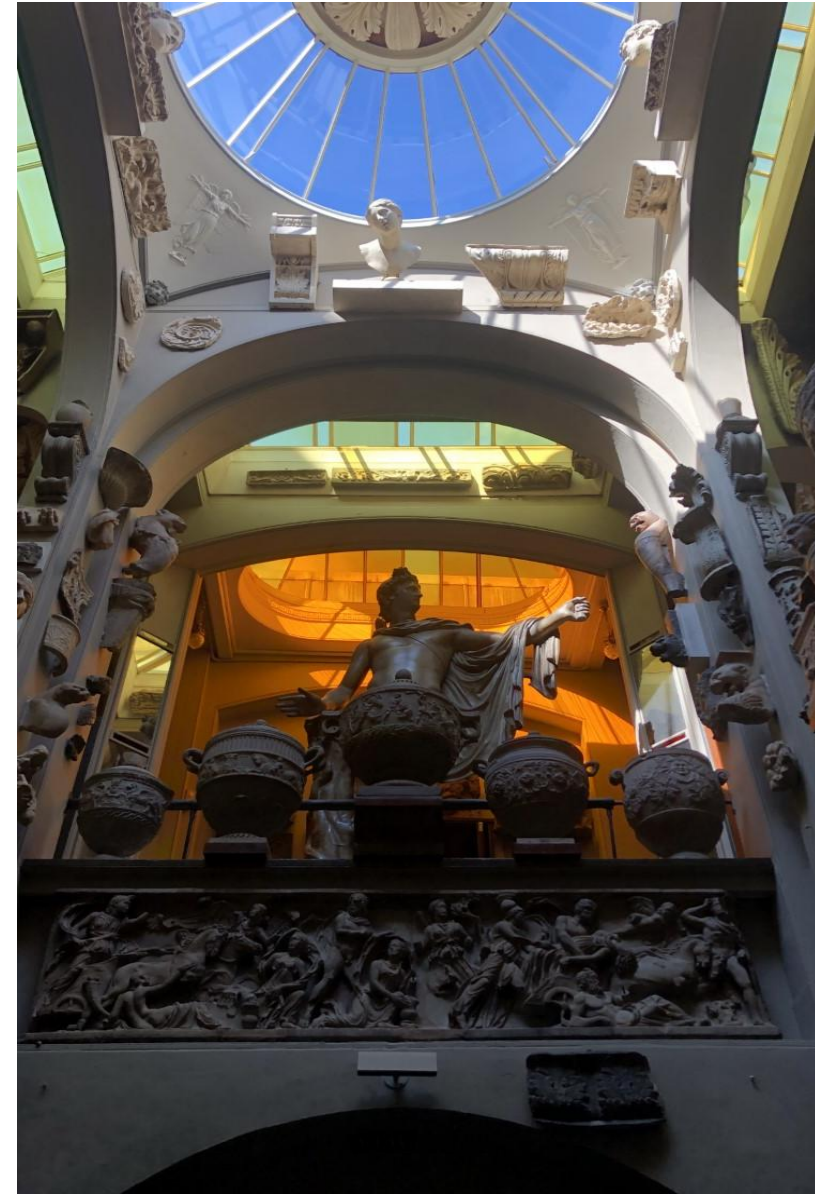
This is the Picture Room. It is full of paintings.



The walls in the Picture Room can open and there are lots more pictures to see.



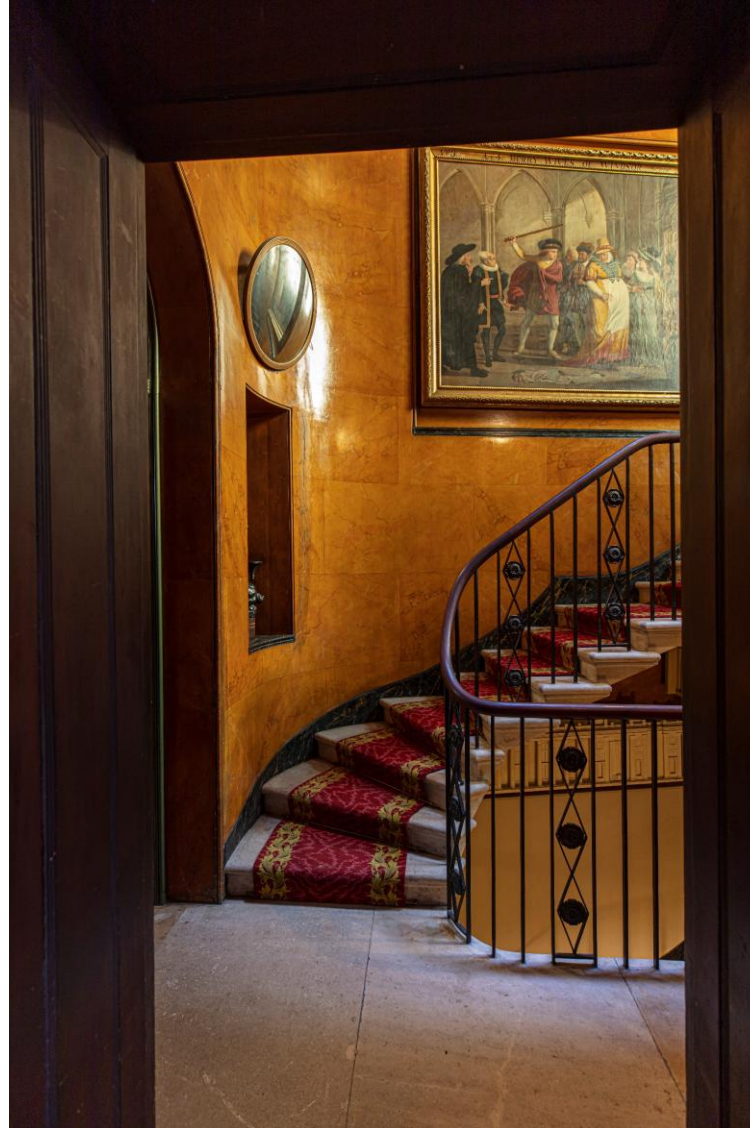
This is the Dome Area.

To finish your visit, you will walk down our long staircase or take the lift.



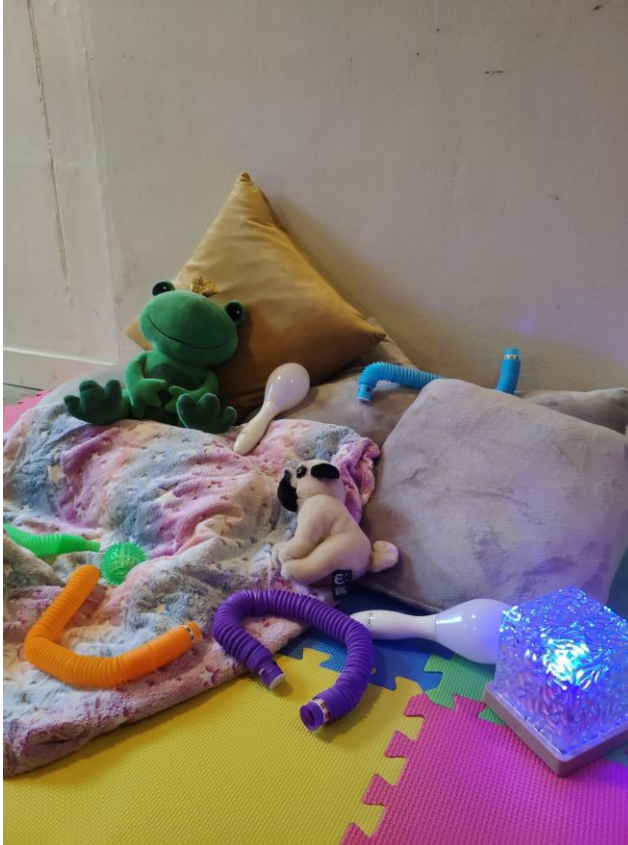
The toilets are at the bottom of the stairs. Ask a member of our friendly staff team if you need help finding them.
